**BOWLING GREEN MAN CHARGED WITH COCAINE TRAFFICKING
AND SALE OF A SAWED-OFF SHOTGUN**

David L. Huber, United States Attorney for the Western District of Kentucky, and Paul Vido, Special Agent in Charge of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), Louisville Field Division, jointly announced that a federal Grand Jury in Bowling Green **returned an Indictment** on February 7, 2007, charging **ZEDRIC DRAWHORN**, age 21, of 1147 Chestnut Street, Bowling Green, Kentucky, in Warren County, with distributing both powder cocaine and crack cocaine. The Indictment also alleges that **Drawhorn** transferred an unregistered sawed-off shotgun to another person.

The Indictment alleges that on three occasions between September 27 and October 2, 2006, **Drawhorn** distributed quantities of cocaine. The Indictment also alleges that on November 22, 2006, **Drawhorn** distributed a quantity of cocaine base, or “crack” cocaine, and sold a sawed-off shotgun. The street value of the cocaine **Drawhorn** allegedly sold was \$1,400.

In the event of a conviction, the maximum potential penalties are 90 years imprisonment, a \$3,250,000 fine, and supervised release for a period of not less than 3 years.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Thomas W. Dyke, and
it

was investigated by the Warren County/Bowling Green Drug Task Force and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

Drawhorn is scheduled to appear for arraignment before the United States Magistrate Judge on February 21, 2007, at 9:30 a.m., in Bowling Green, Kentucky.
