UNITED STATES ATTORNEY REPORTS WEEKLY RESULTS OF ST. LOUIS REGIONAL CEASEFIRE INITIATIVE

St. Louis, Missouri: The following represents the prosecution activities under the St. Louis Regional Ceasefire Initiative, a component of the Bush Administration's Project Safe Neighborhoods Program, United States Attorney Catherine L. Hanaway announced today.

These cases are the result of the collaborative efforts of federal and local law enforcement including the U.S. Attorney's Office, the St. Louis City Circuit Attorney's Office, the St. Louis County Prosecutor's Office, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), the U.S. Marshal's Service, the Drug Enforcement Administration, the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and the St. Louis County Police Department.

This week's results of Project Safe Neighborhood/Ceasefire are as follows:

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

TAYLOR JAMES BLOATE, 45, 5000 block of Werner, St. Louis, 63108, was sentenced to 30 years in prison, followed by 8 years of supervised release, on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm and one felony count of possession with intent to distribute more than 5 grams of crack cocaine.

DARYLL THOMAS, 26, Landrush Court, St. Louis was sentenced to 84 months prison on one felony count of possession with intent to distribute crack cocaine and one felony count of possession of a firearm in relation to a drug trafficking crime.

DELTON CARTER, 38, Pearson Street, St. Louis, was sentenced to 72 months prison on one felony count of possession with intent to distribute heroin and one felony count of using/carrying

a firearm during and in relation to a drug trafficking crime.

JASON KINNARD, 31, 8500 block of Wyndherst, St. Louis, 63132, was sentenced to 72 months prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

JEROME HUNTLEY, 29, Aubert Court, St. Louis, 63133, was sentenced to 30 months prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

ROBERT EARL HURST, 41, Roosevelt Place, St. Louis, 63112, was sentenced to 27 months prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

HENRY CORDOVA ENRIQUEZ, 62, Texas Street, St. Louis, was sentenced to 16 months prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.
