**UNITED STATES ATTORNEY REPORTS WEEKLY RESULTS OF
ST. LOUIS REGIONAL CEASEFIRE INITIATIVE**

St. Louis, Missouri: The following represents the prosecution activities under the St. Louis Regional Ceasefire Initiative, a component of the Bush Administration's Project Safe Neighborhoods Program, United States Attorney Catherine L. Hanaway announced today.

These cases are the result of the collaborative efforts of federal and local law enforcement including the U.S. Attorney's Office, the St. Louis City Circuit Attorney's Office, the St. Louis County Prosecutor's Office, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), the U.S. Marshal's Service, the Drug Enforcement Administration, the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and the St. Louis County Police Department.

This week's results of Project Safe Neighborhood/Ceasefire are as follows:

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

DWAYNE FOWLES, 32, 9600 block of Diamond Drive, St. Louis, 63137, was sentenced to 10 years in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

RASEAN WALKER, 27, 4200 block of Dewey, St. Louis was sentenced to 15 months prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.
