



# BOMBING REWARD Up to \$10,000



The United States Postal Inspection Service (USPIS) and the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) are jointly investigating three (3) separate detonations of suspected improvised explosive devices. These devices commonly referred to as “pipe bombs” were all manufactured using PVC piping. All of these devices were placed inside the residential mailboxes outside three Kentucky homes and then detonated. These detonations occurred at separate times on November 12-14, 2007. The detonations caused only property damage and occurred outside at the following locations:

- 2246 Hammonsville-Jonesville Road, Magnolia, Kentucky
- 796 Ferrill Hill Road, Buffalo, Kentucky
- 7148 Bailey Road, Mount Sherman, Kentucky

The USPIS is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for these bombing.
