Clarksburg Resident Sentenced on Firearms Violation

CLARKSBURG, WEST VIRGINIA — A 33 year old Clarksburg, West Virginia, resident was sentenced on May 12, 2008, in United States District Court in Clarksburg by Judge Irene M. Keeley.

United States Attorney Sharon L. Potter announced that TIMOTHY BRIAN LINDSAY was sentenced to 10 months imprisonment to be followed by three years supervised release, pursuant to an earlier entered plea of guilty. LINDSAY entered a plea of guilty on January 15, 2008, to one count of an Indictment charging LINDSAY, an unlawful user of or addict to a controlled substance, with knowingly possessing a firearm on September 19, 2006, in Clarksburg.

The sentence imposed is to run consecutive to a state sentence of 1-10 years imprisonment.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Shawn Angus Morgan. The case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives; the Harrison/Lewis County Drug & Violent Crime Task Force; and the Clarksburg Police Department. The Task Force consists of officers from the Clarksburg Police Department, the Harrison County Sheriff's Department, the Bridgeport Police Department, the Lewis County Sheriff's Department, and the Drug Enforcement Administration.
