### **ATF OFFERS \$10,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION TO SOLVE SAN BRUNO GUN THEFT**

**SAN BRUNO, Calif.** – Acting Special Agent in Charge Michael P. Gleysteen of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) San Francisco Field Division and Chief Neil Telford of the San Bruno Police Department announced today that ATF will post a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the Sept. 2, 2008, burglary and firearms theft that occurred at Tabors Shooters Supply, 471 El Camino Real, San Bruno, at approximately 4:45 a.m.

The San Bruno Police Department promptly responded to an alarm at the business, however, the person or persons responsible for the break-in and theft had left the scene. Upon preliminary investigation, authorities determined that entry was made into the business by destroying the front door and windows. ATF subsequently joined the investigation and assisted the San Bruno Police Department in a review of the business records and determined that 27 handguns were missing.

“Stolen firearms pose an enormous threat to the community and law enforcement. They are likely to be used to commit violent crimes,” said Acting SAC Gleysteen. “We ask that the public help us to disrupt this path by reporting any information that will lead us to the recovery of these weapons.”

“The San Bruno Police Department is committed to locating, identifying, and charging the suspects,” said Chief Telford.
