BOSTON MAN SENTENCED IN GUN CASE

BOSTON, MA - A Boston man was sentenced today in U.S. District Court for carrying a loaded firearm.

United States Attorney Michael J. Sullivan, Glenn N. Anderson, Special Agent in Charge of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives - Boston Field Division and Police Commissioner Edward Davis of the Boston Police Department announced today that **JAMONT DUBOSE**, age 28, of Maxwell Street in Dorchester, was sentenced by U.S. District Judge Saris to 15 years imprisonment, to be followed by 5 years of supervised release. **DUBOSE** pled guilty to being a felon in possession of a firearm on June 10, 2008.

At the earlier plea hearing, the prosecutor told the Court that had the case proceeded to trial the Government's evidence would have proven that **DUBOSE** was carrying a .22 caliber revolver loaded with 7 rounds of ammunition on February 22, 2007. Some time after 2:00 p.m., two plain clothed officers asked to speak with **DUBOSE** after observing him engage in what appeared to be a drug transaction. During his encounter with the police, **DUBOSE** kept his right hand in his front sweat shirt pocket. Fearing for their safety, officers asked him multiple times to remove his hand from his pocket, which he eventually did reluctantly. For their protection, officers patted down **DUBOSE'S** pocket and felt a hard object. When one of the officers removed a gun from that pocket, **DUBOSE** ran, and both officers pursued him and apprehended him a short distance from the scene.

The case was investigated by the Boston Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. It was prosecuted by Special Assistant U.S. Attorney Gretchen Lundgren of Sullivan's Strike Force Unit, who also serves as an Assistant District Attorney with the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office.
