**BETTENDORF MAN SENTENCED  
ON FEDERAL DRUG CHARGES**

DAVENPORT- On October 6, 2008, Dustin Joseph Dilley, age 22, formerly of Bettendorf, Iowa was sentenced by United States District Court Judge John A. Jarvey to 16 months in federal prison after pleading guilty to possession of stolen firearms, announced United States Attorney Matthew G. Whitaker. McClellon was also ordered to serve two years of supervised release after his imprisonment, and pay an assessment of \$100 to the Crime Victim Fund.

On September 20, 2007, a state search warrant at Dilley's Bettendorf residence resulted in the seizure of numerous stolen firearms. Dilley pled guilty on May 21, 2008. A related defendant, Jae Eads, has pled guilty and is awaiting sentencing.

This case was prosecuted in the United States Attorney's Office in the Southern District of Iowa as part of the Project Safe Neighborhoods initiative. This investigation was conducted by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, and the Scott County Sheriff's Department.
