## **BOWLING GREEN MAN INDICTED ON FEDERAL FIREARMS CHARGE**

*- Convicted felon found in possession of a sawed off shotgun*

BOWLING GREEN, KY - A federal grand jury in Bowling Green returned an indictment against **Lawrence Grogan**, age 45, of 1748 Media Drive, Bowling Green, Kentucky, in Warren County, on charges of illegal possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. U.S. Attorney David L. Huber of the Western District of Kentucky announced today.

The Indictment alleges that on 4-7-08, Grogan, who has a prior felony conviction for a Federal theft charge, was in possession of a sawed off shotgun. He was found out when the police were called to his residence due to a domestic disturbance between Grogan and his wife.

In the event of a conviction, the maximum potential penalties are not more than 10 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, and supervised release for a period of not more than 3 years.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney J. Scott Davis, and it was investigated by the Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms Special Agent, David S. Hayes.

Grogan is scheduled to appear for arraignment before the United States Magistrate Judge on October 22, 2008, at 9:30 a.m., in Bowling Green, Kentucky.
