



POLICE EXECUTE SEARCH WARRANTS IN HIGHLAND PARK

Highland Park, Mich. Five law enforcement agencies are currently conducting search warrants in the City of Highland Park as part of an ongoing investigation into narcotics trafficking. The search warrants are being served at five different locations within a 2.5 square mile area of the city.

"These search warrants were executed in an effort to improve the quality of life for Highland Park citizens," said Captain Annemarie Gibson, commander of the Michigan State Police Southeastern Criminal Investigation Division. "Federal, state and local law enforcement will continue to work together to proactively address crime in the city."

The Michigan State Police, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Wayne County Sheriff's Department and Detroit Police Department are participating in this effort.
