## **ST. LOUIS CIRCUIT ATTORNEY AND UNITED STATES ATTORNEY REPORT WEEKLY RESULTS OF ST. LOUIS REGIONAL CEASEFIRE INITIATIVE**

St. Louis, Missouri: The following represents the prosecution activities under the St. Louis Regional Ceasefire Initiative, a component of the Bush Administration's Project Safe Neighborhoods Program, United States Attorney James G. Martin and St. Louis Circuit Attorney Jennifer Joyce announced today.

These cases are the result of the collaborative efforts of federal and local law enforcement including the U.S. Attorney's Office, the St. Louis City Circuit Attorney's Office, the St. Louis County Prosecutor's Office, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), the U.S. Marshal's Service, the Drug Enforcement Administration, the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department and the St. Louis County Police Department.

This week's results of Project Safe Neighborhood/Ceasefire are as follows:

### **ST. LOUIS CIRCUIT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE:**

Edwin Shead, 19, of the 1400 block of Glasgow pled guilty to murder in the second degree, armed criminal action, and resisting arrest on February 24, 2005. On that date, Shead was sentenced to serve twenty five years in the Missouri Department of Corrections by Judge Jimmie Edwards.

Antoine Hill, 25, of the 3400 block of Oregon was found guilty by a jury on January 14, 2005 of murder in the second degree, armed criminal action, attempted robbery in the first degree and burglary in the first degree. On February 25, 2005 Judge Jimmie Edwards sentenced Hill to serve twenty five years in the Missouri Department of Corrections.

**UNITED STATES ATTORNEY'S OFFICE**

ERIC DAVIS, 23, of the 2700 block of Ann, St. Louis, was sentenced to 84 months in prison on one felony count of conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute over 100 grams of heroin, one felony count of distribution of in excess of 100 grams of heroin, one felony count of possession with intent to distribute in excess of 100 grams of heroin, one felony count of possession with intent to distribute a quantity of marijuana and one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

SHAUN KING, 27, of the 2500 block of California, St. Louis, was sentenced to 24 months in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

JACKIE HELTON, 36, of the 1300 block of Montclair, St. Louis, 63112, was sentenced to 41 months in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

LEE ERIC LUMPKINS, 37, of the 2600 block of Osage, St. Louis, 63118, was sentenced to 48 months in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

DONALD KIM BUCHANAN, 48, of the 4800 block of Hammett, St. Louis, 63113, was sentenced to 30 months in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.

MILTON WILLIAMS, 22, of the 3200 block of Ohio, St. Louis, 63118, was sentenced to 96 months in prison on one felony count of being a previously convicted felon in possession of a firearm.
