BOWLING GREEN DRUG DEALER SENTENCED

David L. Huber, United States Attorney for the Western District of Kentucky, announced today that **CORNELIUS BLEWITT**, age 27, 109 Creekwood Drive, Bowling Green, Kentucky, in Warren County, was **sentenced** for conspiring to distribute crack cocaine and distributing crack cocaine between July 28, 2004, and August 11, 2004, in Warren County.

Joseph H. McKinley, Jr., Judge, United States District Court, sentenced **Blewitt** to 10 years in prison and 8 years of supervised release to begin after his release from prison. **There is no parole in the federal system.**

Blewitt, along with his co-defendant, Jarreous Blewitt, distributed over 20 grams of crack cocaine in Bowling Green between July 28, 2004 and August 11, 2004. **Cornelius Blewitt** engaged in drug trafficking after having been previously convicted of two narcotics felonies in Warren County, Kentucky.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Brian Butler, and it was investigated by the Bowling Green Drug Task Force and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF).
