Madison, Wisconsin -- Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Carl Carter, of McFarland, Wisconsin, DOB: 05/30/83, was sentenced today by Chief U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb to 41 months in prison, followed by a three-year term of supervised release, for unlawfully possessing a firearm as a convicted felon. Carter pleaded guilty to this charge on February 1, 2005.

On June 11, 2004, the Madison Police Department responded to a call regarding an unrelated matter and their investigation in that matter led to a pat-down search of Carter, who was carrying a loaded .25 caliber pistol. Carter has two prior felony convictions for possession with intent to distribute THC.

The charge against Carter was the result of an investigation conducted by the Madison Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney Rita M. Rumbelow.
