Madison, Wisconsin -- Stephen P. Sinnott, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, announced that Robert C. Davis Jr., D.O.B. 4/11/85 of Madison, Wisconsin, pleaded guilty yesterday in U.S. District Court in Madison to unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon. Davis, a convicted felon, was caught with a loaded firearm after a traffic stop on February 6, 2005 in Madison.

U.S. District Judge Barbara B. Crabb scheduled sentencing for August 4, 2004, at 1:20 p.m. Davis faces a maximum penalty of ten years in federal prison.

The charges against Davis were the result of an investigation conducted by the Madison Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives. The prosecution of the case has been handled by Assistant U.S. Attorney David J. Reinhard.
