### **Iowa Man Sentenced on Firearm Charge**

DES MOINES - On October 31, 2006, Jesus Alfredo Delgado, age 24, of Ottumwa, was sentenced to a term of 40 months imprisonment based on his plea of guilty to possessing a firearm after being convicted of a felony, announced United States Attorney Matthew G. Whitaker. Additionally, United States District Judge Ronald E. Longstaff ordered Delgado to serve a three-year term of supervised release after imprisonment and pay a \$100 assessment to the crime victim fund.

On March 2, 2006, Delgado pleaded guilty to the illegal weapon possession charge. At the time of his plea, Delgado stipulated that on September 7, 2005, he was in possession of two firearms. On that day Delgado was involved in a domestic dispute during which the police were called. Subsequently, the car Delgado was driving was stopped by the Ottumwa Police and a handgun was found in the car. On September 9, 2005, a search warrant was conducted on Delgado's residence and a rifle was seized during the search. Delgado has been previously convicted on felony charges in Texas.

This case was investigated by the Ottumwa Police Department, and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.
