Under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 923(e) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73, notice is hereby given of the revocation of the Federal firearms license specified above, in that the Director, Industry Operations, United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives ("ATF"), Charlotte Field Division, has reason to believe that Mark Theron Hunter, doing business as, Sportman Gun & Pawn (hereinafter Mark Hunter), 190 Saluda Street, Chester, South Carolina 29706, willfully violated the provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478.

Compliance History

In or about 2018, ATF issued the current Federal Firearms License to Mark Hunter (FFL# 1-57-06299) as a 01 Dealer in Firearms. Prior to the issuance the current license, Mark Hunter, operated Sportman Gun & Pawn under a 02 Federal Firearms License (FFL#1-57-01075) from 2004 until 2018. ATF conducted compliance inspections of the current license in 2018 that resulted in licensee being cited for five (5) violations. ATF issued a warning letter to licensee following the 2018 inspection.

Basis for Revocation

Licensee willfully failed on at least occasion to timely respond to a request for information contained in the records required to be kept by Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 44 or Title 27, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 478, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 923(g)(7) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.25a.

Licensee failed to respond to a trace reques within 24 hours. The National Tracing Center attempted on multiple occasions to contact the licensee via telephone and email between March 10, 2021 and June 2, 2021.
