If, after the hearing and receipt of these findings, you are dissatisfied with this action you may, within 60 days after receipt of this notice, file a petition pursuant 18 U.S.C. § 923(f)(3), for judicial review with the U.S. District Court for the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business. If you intend to continue operations after the effective date of this action while you pursue filing for judicial review or otherwise, you must request a stay of the action from the Director of Industry Operations (DIO), Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, at 5825 North Sam Houston Parkway West, Suite 300, Houston, Texas 77086

prior to the effective date of the action set forth above. You may not continue licensed operations unless and until a stay is granted by the DIO.

Records prescribed under 27 CFR Part 478 for the license described above shall either be delivered to ATF within 30 days of the date the business is required to be discontinued or shall be documented to reflect delivery to a successor. See 18 U.S.C. 923(g)(4) and 27 CFR § 478.127.

After the effective date of a license denial of renewal, revocation, or suspension, you may not lawfully engage in the business of dealing in firearms. Any disposition of your firearms business inventory must comply with all applicable laws and regulations. Your local ATF office is able to assist you in understanding and implementing the options available to lawfully dispose of your firearms business inventory.

MD Firearms, LLC, (“Licensee”), holds Federal Firearms License 5-76-201-01-3A-04236 issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (“ATF”) pursuant to the Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478 (collectively, “GCA”) as described herein.

On June 30, 2022, ATF issued a Notice to Revoke or Suspend License and/or Impose a Civil Fine, ATF E-Form 4500 (5300.4) (“Notice to Revoke”) advising Licensee that ATF intended to revoke its Federal Firearms License and impose a civil fine in the amount of \$9,491 in accordance with 18 U.S.C. § 922(t)(5) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73. The Notice to Revoke alleged that Licensee willfully violated the provisions of the GCA and the regulations issued thereunder. The Notice to Revoke further specified that if Licensee wished to challenge the revocation, it may file a request with ATF for a hearing “within 15 days after receipt of this notice.” See 18 U.S.C. § 923(f)(2); 27 C.F.R. § 478.73(b).

By letter dated July 27, 2022, Licensee timely requested a hearing to review the Notice to Revoke. As a result, ATF notified Licensee that the hearing would occur on October 26, 2022.

On October 13, 2022, Licensee sent a document entitled Voluntary Surrender of Federal Firearms License to ATF indicating that it was surrendering its license. Licensee indicated that it would terminate its firearms business operations no later than October 15, 2022. Although Licensee timely requested a hearing to review the Notice to Revoke, Licensee’s voluntary surrender prior to the scheduled hearing date is deemed as a withdrawal of Licensee’s request for a hearing.

For reasons set forth in the Notice to Revoke issued on June 30, 2022, the Federal firearms license held by MD Firearms, LLC is hereby REVOKED with an effective date of October 15, 2022. In light of the surrender, ATF will not impose a fine under 18 U.S.C. § 922(t)(5) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73 in this matter.
