Page 3 – ATF Form 5300.13, Final Notice of Denial of Application, Revocation, Suspension and/or Fine of Firearms License

The Shooter's Shop, Inc. ("Licensee"), a Dealer in Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices, (Licensee), holds Federal firearms license 3-39-079-01-3F-01026 issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) pursuant to the Gun Control Act of 1968 (GCA), as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478.

On June 22, 2022, ATF issued a Notice to Revoke or Suspend License and/or Impose a Civil Fine, ATF Form 4500, to the Licensee. The Notice alleged that the Licensee willfully violated the provisions of the GCA and the regulations issued thereunder. The Notice further specified that if the Licensee wished to challenge the revocation, it may file a request with ATF for a hearing "within 15 days after receipt of this notice." See 18 U.S.C. § 923(f)(2); 27 C.F.R. § 478.73(b).

Licensee timely requested a hearing with ATF by letter dated July 1, 2022. A hearing was scheduled for August 31, 2022. On August 30, 2022, Licensee withdrew the request for hearing.

Having no further record, for the reasons set forth in the Notice of Revocation issued on June 22, 2022, the Federal firearms license held by The Shooters Shop, Inc. is hereby REVOKED pursuant to the terms attached hereto and those incorporated into the Form 5300.13. ATF reserves the right to immediately revoke the license if the Licensee violates any of the terms incorporated herein.

Licensee, The Shooters Shop, Inc. and Kevin Nugent as the sole Responsible Person, are found to be willful violators of the Gun Control Act as a result of the Final Notice of Revocation and are not eligible to hold a Federal firearms license or serve as a Responsible Person on a Federal firearms license after October 10, 2022
