Open Letter to All Federal Explosives Licensees and Permittees

Proposed Rulemaking Regarding Explosives Regulations

The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) announces that it is issuing a <u>notice of proposed rulemaking affecting federal explosives regulations</u>. This action is taken, in part, pursuant to the Regulatory Flexibility Act (RFA) which requires an agency to review within ten years of publication, rules for which an agency prepared a final regulatory flexibility analysis addressing the impact of the rules on small businesses or other small entities. This notice does not implement the Safe Explosives Act. Regulations implementing the Safe Explosives Act have not been published as of this date.

Based on comments ATF has received in response to the RFA analysis, this notice proposes amendments to the explosives regulations relating to fireworks. It also proposes to incorporate into the regulations the provisions of an ATF ruling concerning alternate construction standards for storage facilities for explosive materials. This notice also proposes amendments to the regulations that have been initiated by ATF, as well as amendments that have been proposed by members of the explosives industry.

ATF welcomes comments on these proposed regulatory amendments by all interested persons. Comments, however, must be received by April 29, 2003.
