#### **EXCHANGE AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION**

#### Outreach

FIST Branch Chief (b) (7)(C) former RAC in Corpus Christi, TX, spoke about a SWB public awareness initiative that he began in TX and now plans to continue on a national level. The initiative consists of two main components:

- Media Relations SWB success stories, yearly press conferences through the Office of the Director, publication of major firearms seizures
- Public Service Announcements Straw purchasing awareness specific to SWB, billboards, broadcasts, and outreach to faith-based groups, colleges, universities and pawn shops

SWB National Coordinator (b) (7)(C) mentioned that he is working with PGA on Gunrunner standard language talking points for supervisors in the field.

RAC (b) (7)(C) (McAllen) said that ATF has visited five universities in the UT system (Rio Grande Valley) to post signage and distribute hand-outs on straw purchasing. In addition, they have been working with the TX DPS to communicate the campaign message to each DMV.

#### FIELD DIVISION'S MAJOR SWB INVESTIGATIONS

**Dallas FD** – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) reported that the Division has some good trafficking cases currently and that they are seeing illegal firearms purchases moving to east and west Texas.

**Houston FD** – S/A(b)(7)(C) (Corpus Christi) stated that Corpus is a transit point for firearms traffickers and that the group is working OCDETF cases with DEA and ICE.

RAC (b) (7)(C)	reported on the (b) (7)(A)

Los Angeles FD – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) spoke of the need for a trafficking statute since USAs are often unwilling to prosecute firearms traffickers. Penalties should be based on frequency and numbers of firearms trafficked.

SSA (b) (7)(C) mentioned increased collaboration with local LE through to the Joint Regional Intelligence Center (JRIC).

Mexico – MCO Attaché (b) (7)(C) said that they have been receiving quite a few requests from the field for Mexico seizure reports, particularly from the HFD. (b) (7)(C) asked that divisions give a couple of months notice when requesting MCO to view and photograph seized weapons for court.

(b) (7)(C) also mentioned that there is a misconception in Mexico that the firearm used to kill ICE agent Jaime Zapata is linked to ATF's Fast and Furious case.

Analyst Chief (b) (7)(C) reported that members of the MCO and the Firearms Technology Branch reviewed 425 firearms, which were seized in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, on November 6, 2008. The seizure is associated with (b) (7)(C) This is the first time ATF has been able to personally view and photograph the firearms. ATF is comparing old traces and resubmitting traces associated with this seizure in order to support prosecutions on both sides of the border. Some of the firearms included four brand new Barrett .50 caliber rifles in their pelican cases and 11 PS90 5.7mm rifles. Of the 11, one had its serial number obliterated and the remaining 10 were signed over to Mexican Air Force personnel assigned at the Santa Lucia Air Force Base in the State of Mexico.

The ATF case number for this seizure event is 164020-09-0001, 11/06/2008 Seizure – Reynosa, Tamaulipas (b) (7)(C)

(b) (7)(C) reported that SA (b) (7)(C) is working with DEA SIU on the Zapata case and he will reach out to Intel soon.

(b) (7)(C) encouraged the field to send the MCO as much information as possible on ongoing ATF investigations.



#### Outreach

FIST Branch Chief (b) (7)(C) former RAC in Corpus Christi, TX, spoke about a SWB public awareness initiative that he began in TX and now plans to continue on a national level. The initiative consists of two main components:

**Dallas FD** – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) reported that the Division has some good trafficking cases currently and that they are seeing illegal firearms purchases moving to east and west Texas.

**Houston FD** – S/A(b)(7)(C) (Corpus Christi) stated that Corpus is a transit point for firearms traffickers and that the group is working OCDETF cases with DEA and ICE.

Mexico – MCO Attaché (b) (7)(C) said that they have been receiving quite a few requests from the field for Mexico seizure reports, particularly from the HFD. (b) (7)(C) asked that divisions give a couple of months notice when requesting MCO to view and photograph seized weapons for court.

also mentioned that there is a misconception in Mexico that the firearm used to kill ICE agent Jaime Zapata is linked to ATF's Fast and Furious case.

Analyst Chief (b) (7)(C) reported that members of the MCO and the Firearms Technology Branch reviewed 425 firearms, which were seized in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, on November 6, 2008. The seizure is associated with (b) (7)(C) This is the first time ATF has been able to personally view and photograph the firearms. ATF is comparing old traces and resubmitting traces associated with this seizure in order to support prosecutions on both sides of the border. Some of the firearms included four brand new Barrett .50 caliber rifles in their pelican cases and 11 PS90 5.7mm rifles. Of the 11, one had its serial number obliterated and the remaining 10 were signed over to Mexican Air Force personnel assigned at the Santa Lucia Air Force Base in the State of Mexico.







#### **EXCHANGE AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION**

#### Outreach

FIST Branch Chief (b) (7)(C) former RAC in Corpus Christi, TX, spoke about a SWB public awareness initiative that he began in TX and now plans to continue on a national level. The initiative consists of two main components:

- Media Relations SWB success stories, yearly press conferences through the Office of the Director, publication of major firearms seizures
- Public Service Announcements Straw purchasing awareness specific to SWB, billboards, broadcasts, and outreach to faith-based groups, colleges, universities and pawn shops

SWB National Coordinator mentioned that he is working with PGA on Gunrunner standard language talking points for supervisors in the field.

RAC (b) (7)(C) (McAllen) said that ATF has visited five universities in the UT system (Rio Grande Valley) to post signage and distribute hand-outs on straw purchasing. In addition, they have been working with the TX DPS to communicate the campaign message to each DMV.

#### FIELD DIVISION'S MAJOR SWB INVESTIGATIONS

**Dallas FD** – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) reported that the Division has some good trafficking cases currently and that they are seeing illegal firearms purchases moving to east and west Texas.

**Houston FD** – S/A(b)(7)(C) (Corpus Christi) stated that Corpus is a transit point for firearms traffickers and that the group is working OCDETF cases with DEA and ICE.

Los Angeles FD – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) spoke of the need for a trafficking statute since USAs are often unwilling to prosecute firearms traffickers. Penalties should be based on frequency and numbers of firearms trafficked.

SSA (b) (7)(C) mentioned increased collaboration with local LE through to the Joint Regional Intelligence Center (JRIC).

Mexico – MCO Attaché (b) (7)(C) said that they have been receiving quite a few requests from the field for Mexico seizure reports, particularly from the HFD. (b) (7)(C) asked that divisions give a couple of months notice when requesting MCO to view and photograph seized weapons for court.

(b) (7)(C) also mentioned that there is a misconception in Mexico that the firearm used to kill ICE agent Jaime Zapata is linked to ATF's Fast and Furious case.

Analyst Chief (b) (7)(C) reported that members of the MCO and the Firearms Technology Branch reviewed 425 firearms, which were seized in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, on November 6, 2008. The seizure is associated with (b) (7)(C) This is the first time ATF has been able to personally view and photograph the firearms. ATF is comparing old traces and resubmitting traces associated with this seizure in order to support prosecutions on both sides of the border. Some of the firearms included four brand new Barrett .50 caliber rifles in their pelican cases and 11 PS90 5.7mm rifles. Of the 11, one had its serial number obliterated and the remaining 10 were signed over to Mexican Air Force personnel assigned at the Santa Lucia Air Force Base in the State of Mexico.

The ATF case number for this seizure event is 164020-09-0001, 11/06/2008 Seizure – Reynosa, Tamaulipas (b) (7)(C)

(b) (7)(C) reported that SA (b) (7)(C) is working with DEA SIU on the Zapata case and he will reach out to Intel soon.

(b) (7)(C) encouraged the field to send the MCO as much information as possible on ongoing ATF investigations.

(b) (7)(C) also reported that the MCO has responded to every car bombing in Mexico, except one.
(b) (7)(C) and (b) (7)(C) of the USBDC in OSII HQ are able to work high side information on Mexico bombings.

**Phoenix FD** – Las Cruces RAC (b) (7)(C) reported that he attended a meeting with SAC Newell and Senator Jeff Bingaman to discuss ATF's difficulty in investigating firearms traffickers due to constitutional prohibitions.

#### **EXCHANGE AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION**

#### Outreach

FIST Branch Chief (b) (7)(C) former RAC in Corpus Christi, TX, spoke about a SWB public awareness initiative that he began in TX and now plans to continue on a national level. The initiative consists of two main components:

- Media Relations SWB success stories, yearly press conferences through the Office of the Director, publication of major firearms seizures
- Public Service Announcements Straw purchasing awareness specific to SWB, billboards, broadcasts, and outreach to faith-based groups, colleges, universities and pawn shops

SWB National Coordinator (b) (7)(C) mentioned that he is working with PGA on Gunrunner standard language talking points for supervisors in the field.

RAC (b) (7)(C) (McAllen) said that ATF has visited five universities in the UT system (Rio Grande Valley) to post signage and distribute hand-outs on straw purchasing. In addition, they have been working with the TX DPS to communicate the campaign message to each DMV.

#### FIELD DIVISION'S MAJOR SWB INVESTIGATIONS

**Dallas FD** – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) reported that the Division has some good trafficking cases currently and that they are seeing illegal firearms purchases moving to east and west Texas.

**Houston FD** – S/A(b)(7)(C) (Corpus Christi) stated that Corpus is a transit point for firearms traffickers and that the group is working OCDETF cases with DEA and ICE.

RAC (b) (7)(C) reported on the (b) (7)(A)
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Los Angeles FD – FIG GS (b) (7)(C) spoke of the need for a trafficking statute since USAs are often unwilling to prosecute firearms traffickers. Penalties should be based on frequency and numbers of firearms trafficked.

SSA (b) (7)(C) mentioned increased collaboration with local LE through to the Joint Regional Intelligence Center (JRIC).

Mexico – MCO Attaché (b) (7)(C) said that they have been receiving quite a few requests from the field for Mexico seizure reports, particularly from the HFD. (b) (7)(C) asked that divisions give a couple of months notice when requesting MCO to view and photograph seized weapons for court.

(b) (7)(C) also mentioned that there is a misconception in Mexico that the firearm used to kill ICE agent Jaime Zapata is linked to ATF's Fast and Furious case.

Analyst Chief (b) (7)(C) reported that members of the MCO and the Firearms Technology Branch reviewed 425 firearms, which were seized in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, on November 6, 2008. The seizure is associated with (b) (7)(C) This is the first time ATF has been able to personally view and photograph the firearms. ATF is comparing old traces and resubmitting traces associated with this seizure in order to support prosecutions on both sides of the border. Some of the firearms included four brand new Barrett .50 caliber rifles in their pelican cases and 11 PS90 5.7mm rifles. Of the 11, one had its serial number obliterated and the remaining 10 were signed over to Mexican Air Force personnel assigned at the Santa Lucia Air Force Base in the State of Mexico.

(b) (7)(C) reported that SA (b) (7)(C) is working with DEA SIU on the Zapata case and he will reach out to Intel soon.

(b) (7)(C) encouraged the field to send the MCO as much information as possible on ongoing ATF investigations.

(b) (7)(C) also reported that the MCO has responded to every car bombing in Mexico, except one.
(b) (7)(C) and (b) (7)(C) of the USBDC in OSII HQ are able to work high side information on Mexico bombings.

**Phoenix FD** – Las Cruces RAC (b) (7)(C) reported that he attended a meeting with SAC Newell and Senator Jeff Bingaman to discuss ATF's difficulty in investigating firearms traffickers due to constitutional prohibitions.

San Francisco FD – Las Vegas RACI(b) (7)(C) provided an update on Operation BROWNE Stalker (7896085-10-0043), in which approximately 30 firearms were trafficked. This investigation began after Mexican authorities raided a "Los Zetas" training camp in Higueras, Nuevo Leon, and recovered 158 firearms.
