

PRESS RELEASE

On Sunday, March 24, 2019, Joliet Metropolitan Area Narcotics Squad (JMANS) and agents from the Chicago Field Division of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) negotiated the purchase of four (4) semi-automatic handguns and one (1) semi-automatic rifle in Joliet, Illinois. The weapons were purchased from Allen Estrada, age 27, of White Settlement, Texas. The agents had purchased on a previous occasion, three (3) semi-automatic handguns and three (3) semi-automatic rifles along with ammunition from Estrada. Upon a successful transaction, Estrada was taken into custody. During a search of Estrada, an additional semi-automatic handgun was located along with a 30-round magazine. In all, eight (8) semi-automatic handguns, four (4) semi-automatic rifles, ammunition, several handgun/rifle magazines, \$8,000 USC, and a vehicle were seized.

Estrada was transported and booked into the Will County Adult Detention Facility on one (1) count of gunrunning and six (6) counts of armed habitual criminal. Estrada is currently being held on a \$2,000,000.00 bond.

JMANS is comprised of personnel from the Illinois State Police, Bolingbrook Police Department, Grundy County Sheriff's Department, Joliet Police Department, Lockport Police Department, Morris Police Department, Will County Sheriff's Department, and the Will & Grundy County State's Attorney's Offices.

The listed charges are merely an accusation, and the defendants are presumed innocent unless proven guilty.
