Under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 923(e) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73, notice is hereby given of the revocation of the Federal firearms license specified above, in that the Director, Industry Operations, United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives ("ATF"), Charlotte Field Division, has reason to believe that Gregory Allen Corder, doing business as, Corder Custom Firearms (hereinafter Licensee), 109 Labrador Drive, Union Grove, North Carolina 28689, willfully violated the provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478.

## History

On or about March 4, 2016, ATF conducted an application inspection with Licensee. At the conclusion of the inspection, Gregory Allen Corder reviewed and signed an Acknowledgment of Federal Firearms Regulations. ATF issued a Type 07 Manufacturer's License shortly thereafter.

## Current Inspection

On or about November 22, 2021, ATF Industry Operations Investigator (b)(6) conducted a compliance inspection of the licensee's premises. The inspection revealed the following:

 Licensee willfully failed on two (2) occasions to conduct a NICS background check or obtain a valid NICS alternative permit in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(t) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.102(a). Licensee accepted a Concealed Carry Permit issued by the State of South Carolina instead of conducting a NICS background check.
