FFL may transfer the firearm after the Federally mandated 3-day period for delay responses.
	Unresolved/Open	State agency is currently reviewing the background check. FFL may transfer firearms after the Federally mandated 3-day period for delay responses.
Denied	Denied	FFL cannot transfer firearm(s).
Cancelled	Cancelled	Background check stopped prior to final response being provided by the state. Firearm cannot be transferred.
