Delay	Research/Delay	Utilized for any checks that require a manual review, not given instant Approval, regardless of the timeframe needed for such review. FFL may transfer firearm after expiration of federally mandated 3 business day period for background check response.
Deny	Deny	Firearm cannot be transferred.
Cancelled	No State Equivalent	State does not issue “cancelled” responses.

Unique Transaction Number (Format Notes and/or Issuance Timelines):

A unique transaction number is issued at the time the background check is initiated.
