Deny	Deny	FFL cannot transfer the firearm(s).
Cancelled	Approved No Sale	Background check stopped prior to final response being provided by state.

Unique Transaction Number (Format Notes and/or Issuance Timelines):

The Virginia State Police obtain a NIC Transaction Number from the FBI NICS system, which is used as the transaction number attached to a specific background check.
