I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open Court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT 1

From on or about June 27, 2011 through on or about July 12, 2011, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

RICKIE JOE RAKES, JR.,
a/k/a "Joseph A. Miller,"

did knowingly and willfully engage in the business of dealing in firearms without having a license to do so, and in the course of such business, shipped, transported, and received firearms in interstate and foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(a)(1)(A).

COUNT 2

On or about June 27, 2011, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

RICKIE JOE RAKES, JR.,
a/k/a "Joseph A. Miller,"

having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Middlesex County, did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce a firearm, namely a Savage 12 gauge shotgun bearing serial number XZ514.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922 (g) (1) .
