The Grand Jury charges that:

U.S. DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT OF RHODE ISLAND

COUNT I

On or about March 24, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Mossberg .12 gauge shotgun, serial number K197970, and 18 rounds, more or less, of .12 gauge ammunition, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT II

On or about April 29, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Colt Python, .357 caliber revolver with an obliterated serial number, and 13 rounds, more or less, of .357 ammunition, in and affecting

interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT III

On or about July 2, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Harrington & Richardson, model 732, .32 caliber revolver, serial number AS51674, and two rounds, more or less, of .32 caliber ammunition in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT IV

On or about October 15, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Norinco 7.62 rifle, serial number 23004117, and 46 rounds, more or less, of 7.62 ammunition, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. $\S\S$ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT V

On or about January 20, 2011, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of

imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm, that is, a Smith and Wesson, Model 686, .357 caliber revolver, serial number AEH7279, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT VI

On or about February 8, 2011, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Keltec, Model P-11, 9mm pistol, serial number 63705, and 7 rounds, more or less, of .9mm ammunition, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT VII

On or about March 18, 2011, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm, that is, a Beretta, Model 950, .25 caliber pistol, serial number BER75596V, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. \$\$ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT VIII

On or about March 23, 2011, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Phoenix Arms, .25 caliber pistol, serial number 3098064, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT IX

On or about July 28, 2011, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," who was previously convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm, that is, a Fabrique National, .9mm pistol, serial number 607145, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. $\S\S$ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT X

On or about April 29, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," did knowingly and intentionally possess a firearm, that is, a Colt, .357 caliber revolver, which had its serial number removed, obliterated and altered, and which firearm had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce,

All in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(k) and 924(a)(1)(B).

COUNT XI

On or about March 26, 2010, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute and distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base, a Schedule II Controlled Substance,

All in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Counts I through ${\tt X}$ of this Indictment, the defendant, CARLOS VAZQUEZ, a/k/a "Crazy Carlos," shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to 18 U.S.C. \$924(d)\$ and 28 U.S.C. \$2461(c), the firearms identified inCounts I through X of the Indictment.

(Felon in Possession of a Firearm, 18 U.S.C. §§ 922 (g)(1) and 924 (a)(2))

MAX PENALTY FOR EACH COUNT:

- a. 10 years imprisonment;
- b. \$250,000 fine;
- c. 3 years to life supervised release; and
- d. \$100 special assessment.

Count X:

(Possession of a firearm with obliterated and altered serial number, 18 U.S.C. §§ 922 (k) and 924 (a)(1)(B))

- a. 5 years imprisonment;
- b. \$250,000 fine;
- c. 3 years supervised release; and
- d. \$100 special assessment.

Count XI:

(Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine, 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C))

- a. 20 years imprisonment;
- b. \$1,000,000 fine;
- c. 3 years to life supervised release; and
- d. \$100 special assessment.
