The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

[18 U.S.C. § 844(i)]

On or about April 7, 2011, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant RON HIRSCH, also known as ("aka") "Ronald Jay Fisher," aka "Israel Fisher," maliciously damaged, by means of an explosive, the building and real property known as the Chabad House in Santa Monica, located at 1428 17th Street, Santa Monica, California, which real property and

building was used in interstate and foreign commerce, and in activities affecting interstate and foreign commerce.

COUNT TWO

[18 U.S.C. § 844(h)(1)]

On or about April 7, 2011, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant RON HIRSCH, also known as ("aka") "Ronald Jay Fisher," aka "Israel Fisher," knowingly used an explosive to commit a felony prosecutable in a court of the United States, namely, use of an explosive to damage property, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 844(i), as charged in Count One of this Indictment.

COUNT THREE

[18 U.S.C. § 924(c)(1)(A), (B)(ii)]

On or about April 7, 2011, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant RON HIRSCH, also known as ("aka") "Ronald Jay Fisher," aka "Israel Fisher," knowingly used a destructive device, during and in relation to a crime of violence, namely, use of an explosive to damage property, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 844(i), as charged in Count One of this Indictment.

COUNT FOUR

[26 U.S.C. § 5861(d)]

On or about April 7, 2011, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, and elsewhere, defendant RON HIRSCH, also known as ("aka") "Ronald Jay Fisher," aka "Israel Fisher," knowingly possessed a firearm, namely, a "destructive device," as that term is defined in Title 26, United States Code, Sections 5845(a)(8) and 5845(f), which firearm was not registered to him in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record.
