A pmlan-spuecze revulrel:..

Alsingle $1.5 \%$-inch barrel gim, chambered to lire 3 gitige shotghn shells, with satwed-off sook, altered in such a manner as to change the characterislies of the origimal weapon so that it camot be classified either as a shotern or pistol in the commonly accepted definition of those words.
A dipper percussion gun, which is made of bronee and which fires abmut an. 3 caliber projectile hy means of a perenssion cap, ank is $131 / 2$ inehes overall in length, with a culp atached to one emb.

A gun made by using a 3 -20 rifle barel mounted ous the receiver or fatme of a 410 gange shotgm, with a pistal type grip at an angle on the bore for kokling in one hand and designed to discharge a shot by the action of an explosive.
The following weapons are not firearms within the meaning of sec-


A pistol grip type German Flare gun with two barrels $6 \frac{1}{2}$ inches in lenget which is not capable of firing shotgun shells.

A twelve nampe, 30 ineh double-barrel shofgun, one barrel of which has heen sawed ofl to $141 / 2$ inches. Since the 1 emaining burrel is 30 juches in length, the weipou is not considered as caprable of being conceated on the person.
Section 9733 ( $b$ ) of the luternal Revenue Code defines a machine gun as "any of her weapon which shenots, of is designed to shont, automaticully or semiantomatically, more than one shot, withont manal relonding, by a single function of the trigger."
 was allered by removing the origrinal breech mechanism so that the action and barrel assimbly of a 2 caliber short rim-fire antoloading semiautomatic rifle, Iess woolen stock, forearm and sights, could be craciled on the inside of the breech of the gun by use of brackets, Sucla gim then was capable of firing .29 caliber rim-fire ammunition and is operated by menns of a 110 wolt switch-controlled electric motor with a set of beveled gears to trausmit motion of the motor to the trigger mechanismo of the rille, so that when the trigger of the gun is prillect, inotion of the electric motor is trimsmitted to the mechnuism of the rifle, thoms firing the gun as long as the tripgree is hedd back or until the 1 t -shot tubular marazine is emptied. This weapon is classified as $\Omega$ "machine gun" within the menning of section 2733 (b) of the Code.
