

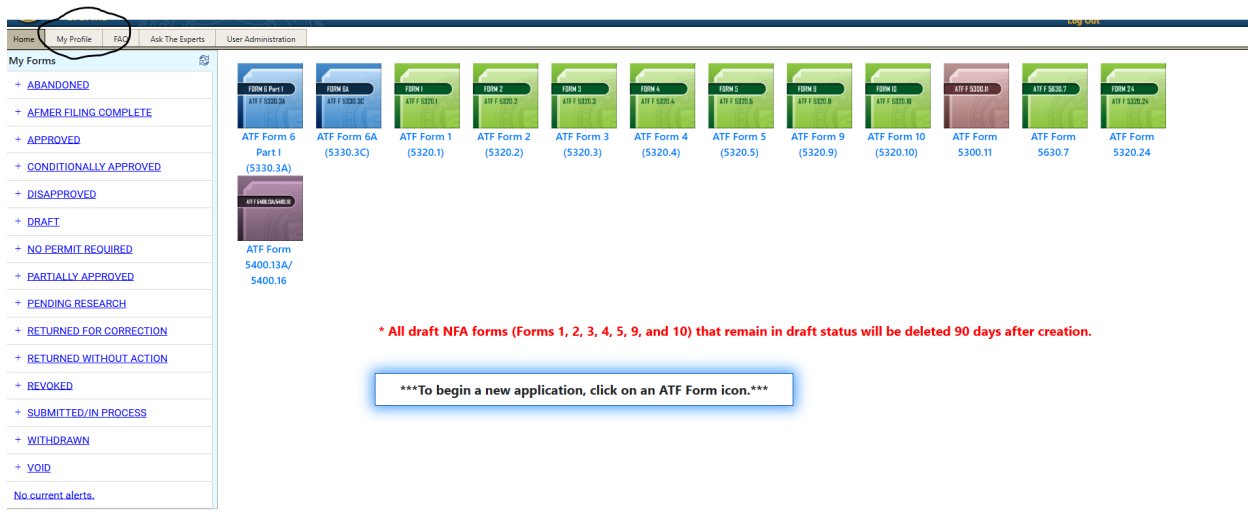
Active Inventory

Once the FFL has been associated with your eForms account, you may view all active inventory that is registered under that FFL. If you have multiple FFLs, you will need to associate each FFL with your eForms account separately. The active inventory phrase is used to identify all current NFA weapons in your possession whether a restriction applies or not.

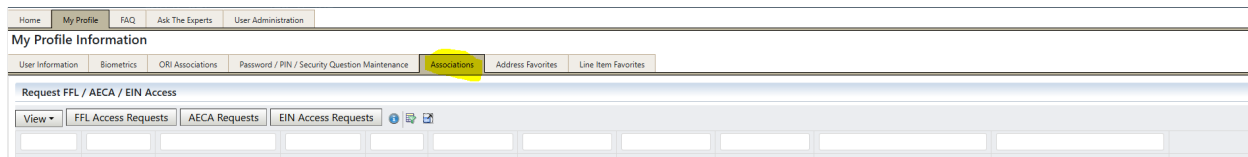
Viewing your Active Inventory
