Press Release: Operation Crime Driver

On Friday, 03 May 2019, the Tipton County Sheriff's Office in partnership with District Attorney General Mark Davidson, along with the assistance of multiple state and federal agencies, conducted an operation that spanned from Lauderdale County to Shelby County. The operation focused on compliance checks for those individuals who are currently on probation or parole in lieu of incarceration. Additionally, those with active warrants were also sought.

The operation was conducted by 17 teams comprised of well over 100 law enforcement officers from the Tipton County Sheriff's Office, the 25th Judicial District Attorney General's Office, 25th Judicial District Drug Task Force, Multi-Agency Gang Unit (Memphis Police Department and Shelby County Sheriff's Office personnel), Alcohol, Tobacco, & Firearms (ATF), Tennessee Highway Patrol, Tennessee Department of Corrections, Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, Tipton County Central Dispatch, United States Marshals Service, and the United States Attorney's Office.
