

## Armed Robbery Ends in Agent Involved Shooting

A suspect has died and a Lakewood Police Agent is injured after an armed robbery that ended in an agent involved shooting.

At approximately 1:43 P.M., Lakewood Police were called to the 400 block of South Oak St. for a report of an armed robbery. The victim, a mail carrier, was on his route when two juvenile Hispanic females approached him and robbed him at gunpoint. The suspects then ran off.

Lakewood Agents located one of the suspects near the Grease Monkey located at 10880 West Alameda Ave. The suspect was confronted by Agents and pointed her gun at them. The Agents fired, striking the suspect. Agents immediately began life-saving measures, and the suspect was transported to a local hospital. Several hours later the suspect died of her injuries. Because of her age, her identity is not being released at this time.

The second female suspect fled the scene following the armed robbery. She was later found and taken into custody in custody by ATF Agents and Lakewood Police in Frederick, CO.

The Lakewood Agent that was hit suffered non life-threatening injuries and is expected to make a full recovery.
